Yield Monitor Tips for Harvest



Calibrating grain yield monitors at harvest can be confusing and time consuming for a combine operator. However, improperly calibrated yield monitors can generate erroneous data that becomes useless or difficult to interpret. Taking the time to calibrate a yield monitor properly pays off when it comes to using yield map data for post-harvest analyses or supporting crop management decisions based on your yield data. 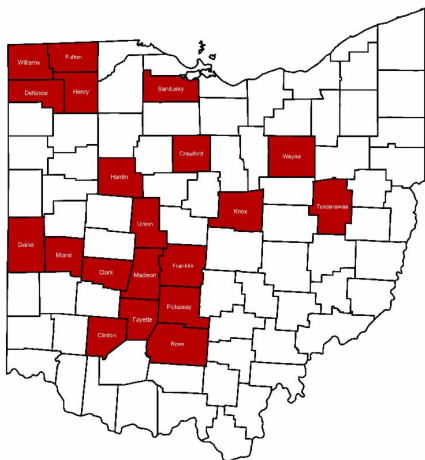

The 2018 eFields Report is in the works! The Ohio State Digital Ag team has been working hard to bring you a new record amount of information including data from:

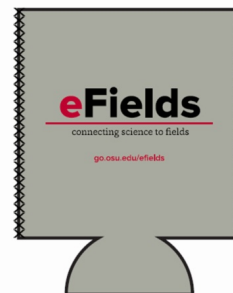
- 20 counties

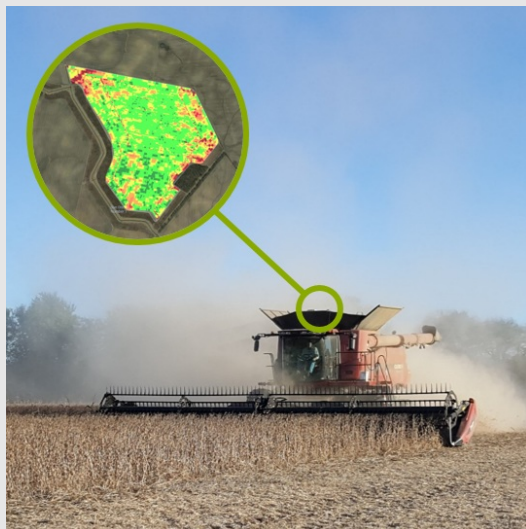
