2018 eFields Report Coming Soon!

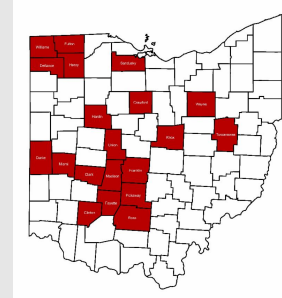

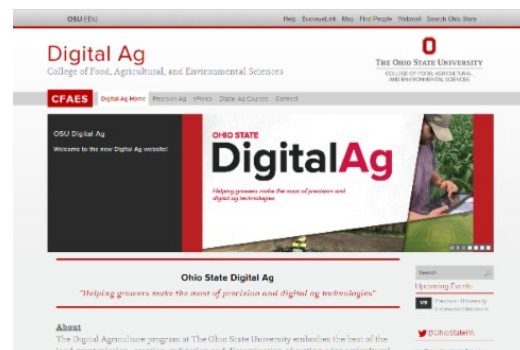
